You are forthwith by your order

to advertise and lay out unto Robert Granston a lot of

Land to consist of two hundred acres situated on the South

East Entrance of Margaret River to be in behind the Common

And to make a plan thereof into the Secretary's office

within six months from this date with a plan or description

of the same to certify the Nature and Quality of

the same, conformable to His Majesty's Instructions in

case that a Crown Land may pass for the same and

providing this shall be your command

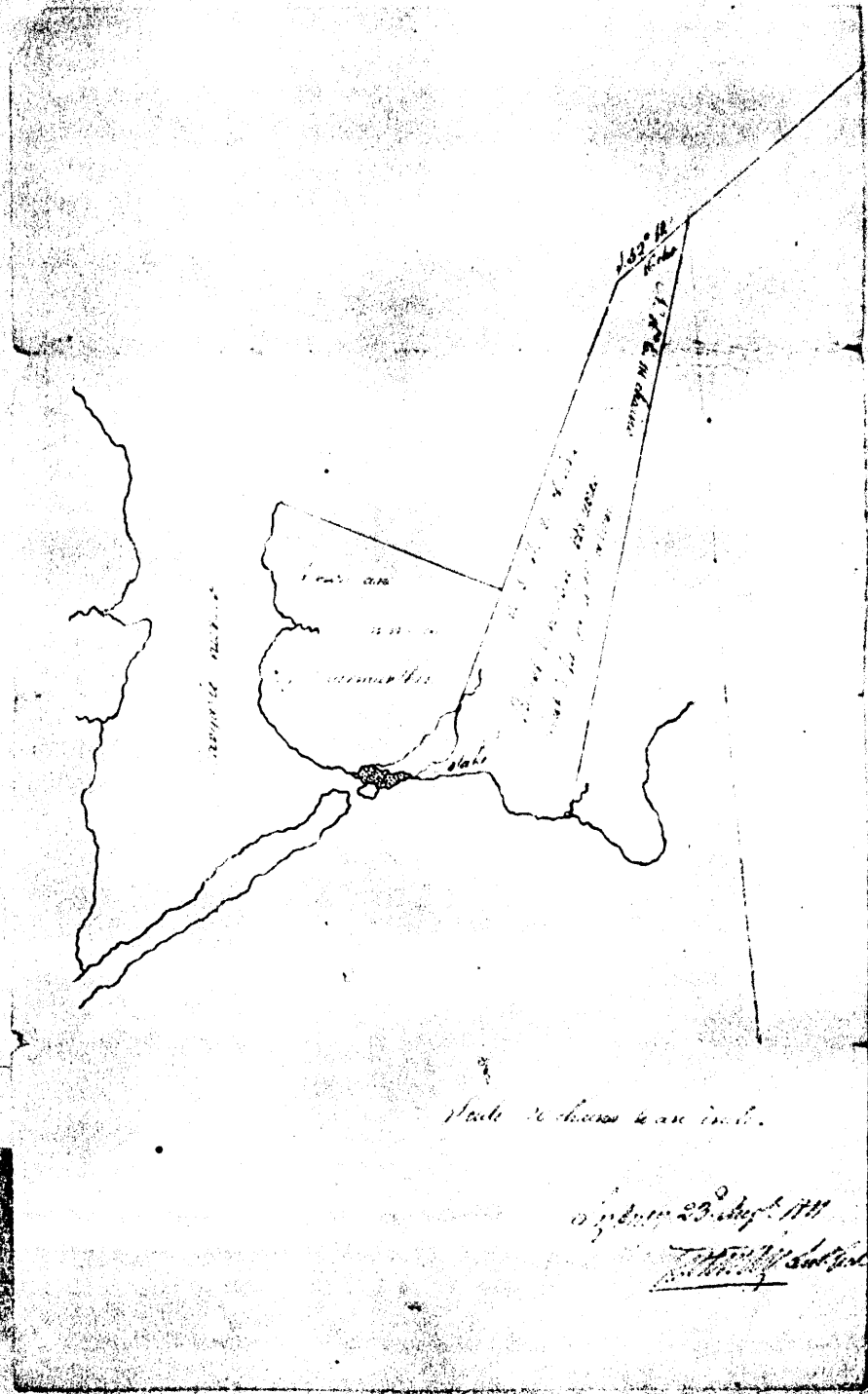

President of His Majesty's Council -----

To The Honorable Thomas Crawley Surveyor General

You are forthwith by Yourself or Deputy
to admeasure and lay out unto Robert Cranston a lot of
Land to Consist of Two Hundred Acres situate on the South
East Entrance of Margurie River to pass behind the Commons
And to make a due return thereof unto the Secretary's
office within Six Months from this date with a plot or
Description annexed thereto as also to Certify the Nature
and Quality of the farm, conformable to His Majesty's
Instructions ----- that a Crown Lease may-----
for the farm and for so doing this shall be your warrant
